



Following the Impact of COVID-19 Pandemic on Server & Enterprise Storage Budget

Wave 3 Survey April 2020

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Executive Summary

Total IT Spending: Respondents outside of USA appear more optimistic. This is especially noticeable within the full year 2020 expectations, where 45% of USA respondents now expect lower IT spending vs. 33% of WW respondents.

Enterprise Server Spending: Shifts between Wave 2 and Wave 3 appear relatively stable at the WW level. Whereas Wave 3 USA results suggest a strong increase in the degree to which 2020 server budgets will decrease.

Enterprise Storage Spending: WW storage budgets also remained relatively stable. Wave 3 results show a pessimistic shift, with increases to the share of respondents expecting a 10% or more decrease in storage spending.



Research Objectives

This is the Third Bi-Weekly Survey Exploring IT Buyers Expectations Related to the Impact COVID-19 will Have on IT Budgets

- This tracking survey is the third of a series that is created every two weeks to capture IT spending behavior during (and in the aftermath of) the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The survey was conducted in more than a dozen countries representing North America, EMEA and Asia Pacific.
- This IDC deliverable provides insights related to top-line IT spending, enterprise servers and enterprise storage. Additional survey results spanning 20+ technology categories have been published within IDC's respective research domains.
- Each survey wave was complete on the following dates:
 - Wave 1: March 28, 2020
- Wave 2: April 15, 2020
- Wave 3: April 30, 2020



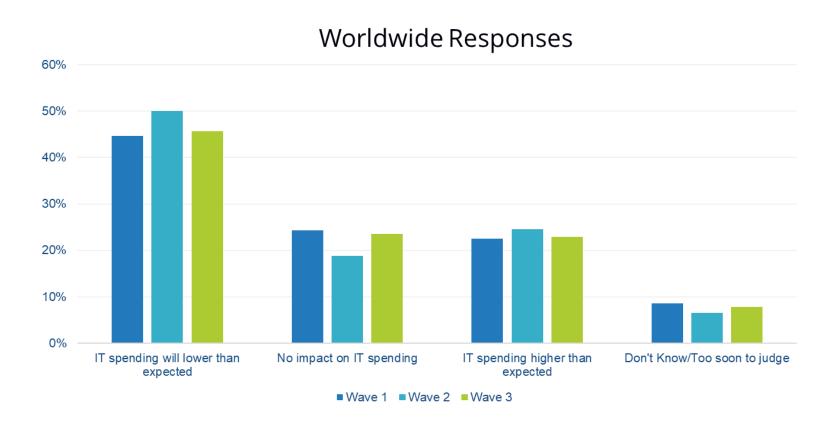


Key Analysis and Findings



Expected Impact on WW IT Budgets: Second Quarter

Compared to your organization's originally budgeted IT spending plans, which of the following best reflects your opinion of how COVID-19 will impact your organization's actual IT spending in the second quarter of 2020 (April to June)?



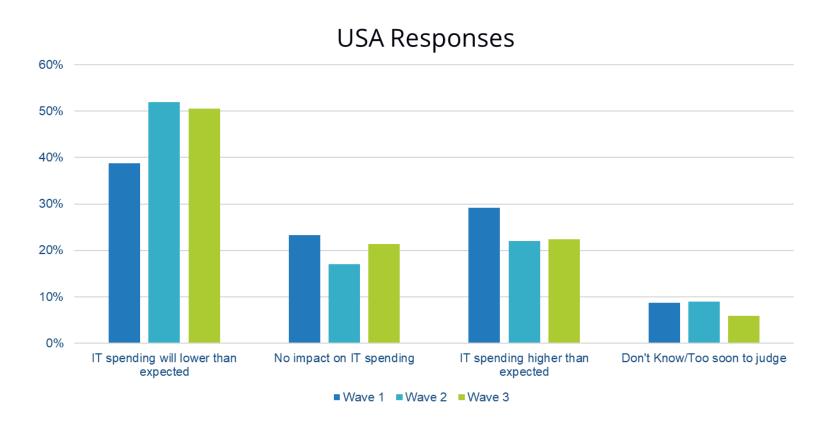
Share of worldwide respondents expecting lower 2Q spending for total IT remains above 45%

Wave 3 results suggests fewer respondents are expecting higher 2Q spending, yet more are now expecting no impact to IT spending.



Expected Impact on USA IT Budgets: Second Quarter

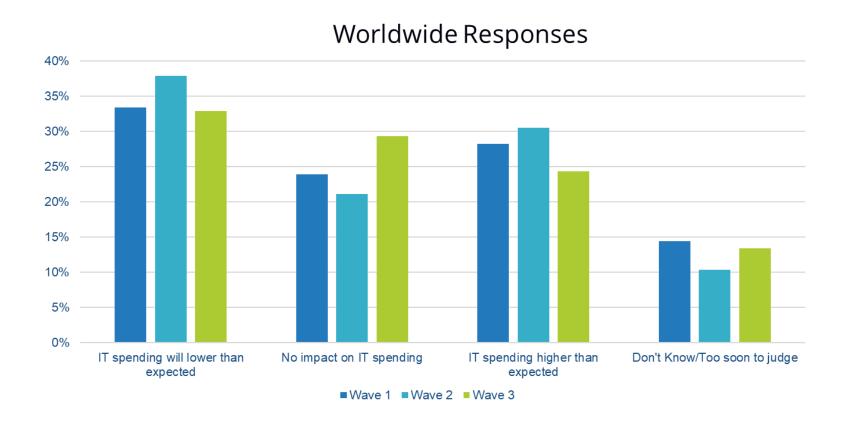


Wave 2 and Wave 3 responses were similar, with slightly more Wave 3 respondents indicating no impact to IT spending in Q2



Expected Impact on WW IT Budgets: Full Year 2020

Compared to your organization's originally budgeted IT spending plans, which of the following best reflects your opinion of how COVID-19 will impact your organization's actual IT spending for the full year (2020)?



Share of worldwide respondents expecting lower 2020 IT spending has fallen to 33% in Wave 3.

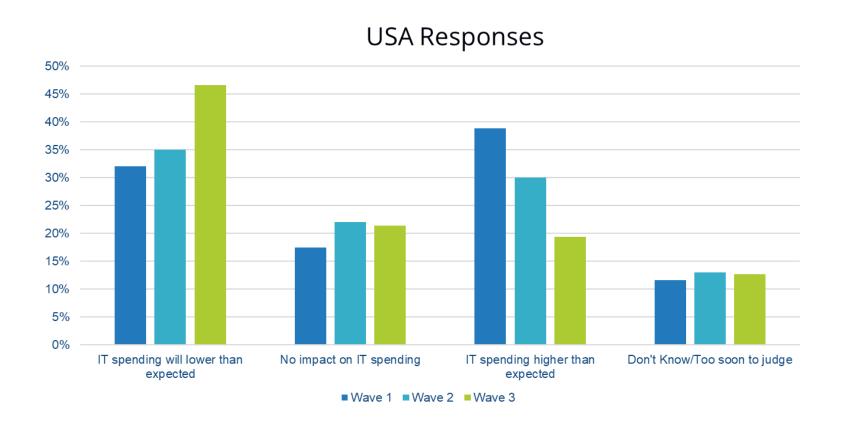
Largest Wave 3 shift comes from those expecting no impact to 2020 IT spending.

Fewer respondents (24%) of Wave 3 expect 2020 IT spending to increase.



Expected Impact on USA IT Budgets: Full Year 2020

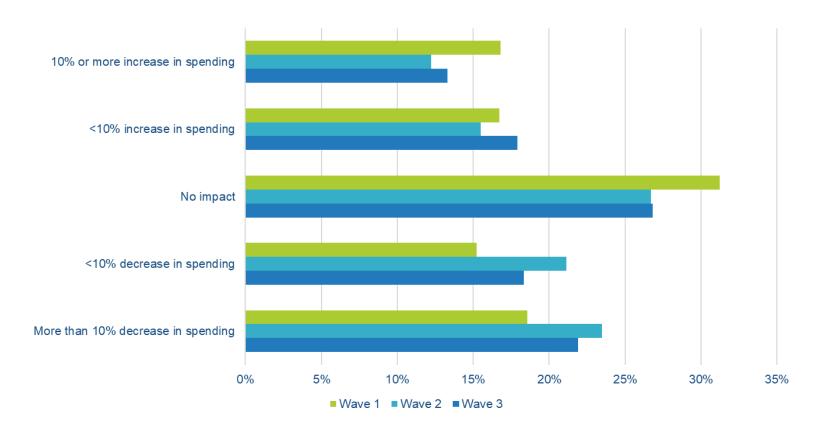
USA results show an increasingly pessimistic view of IT spending for the full year.

Wave 3 results show a sharp decrease of respondents expecting higher spending when compared to Wave 1 & Wave 2.



Impact on Full Year 2020 Server Budgets: Worldwide

Compared to your organization's originally budgeted IT spending plans, in 2020 overall, how do you think your organization's actual spending on SERVERS will be affected due to COVID-19?



More respondents in Wave 3 anticipate increases to 2020 server spending compared to Wave 2.

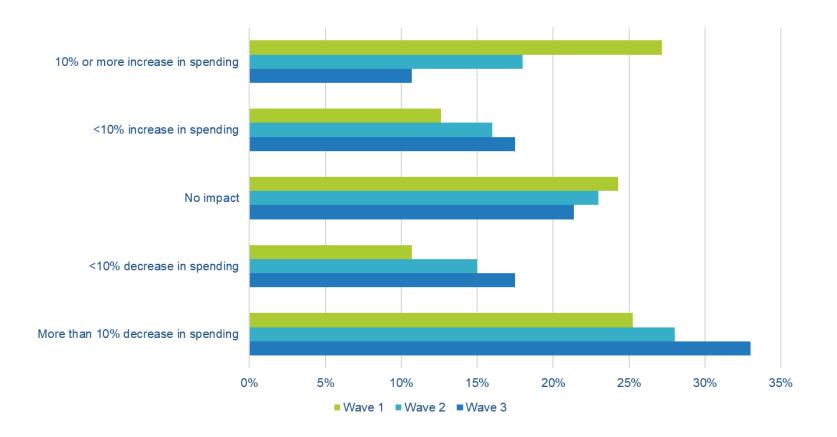
Similar share of respondents in Waves 2 & Wave 3 expect no 2020 server spending changes.

Fewer respondents in Wave 3 anticipate decreases to 2020 server spending compared to those in Wave 2.



Impact on Full Year 2020 Server Budgets: USA

Compared to your organization's originally budgeted IT spending plans, in 2020 overall, how do you think your organization's actual spending on SERVERS will be affected due to COVID-19?

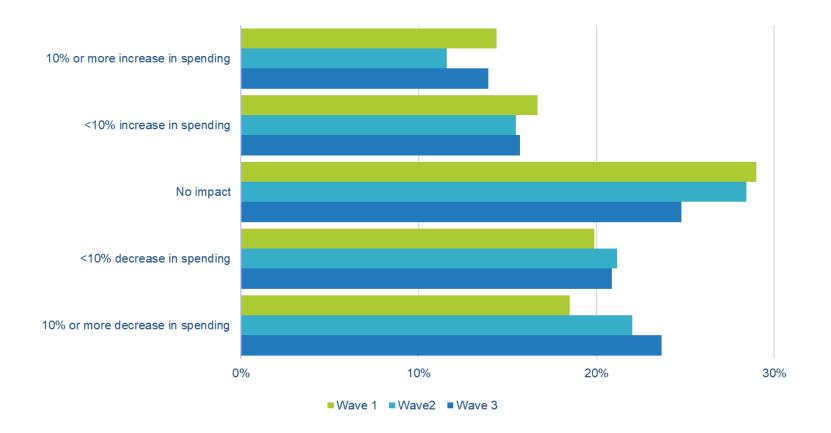


For those planning on server spending increases, Wave 3 respondents are planning for smaller 2020 spending increases compared with Wave 2 US respondents

There are also upticks in the frequency of planned decreases in US server spending for respondents in Wave 3 compared with Wave 2

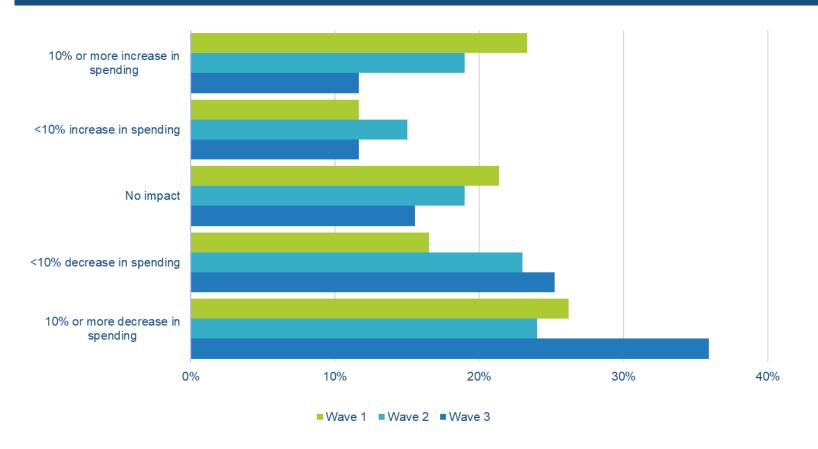
Wave 3 survey results show a shift towards extremes of the ranges provided at the cost of those not expecting any impact to 2020 enterprise storage spending.

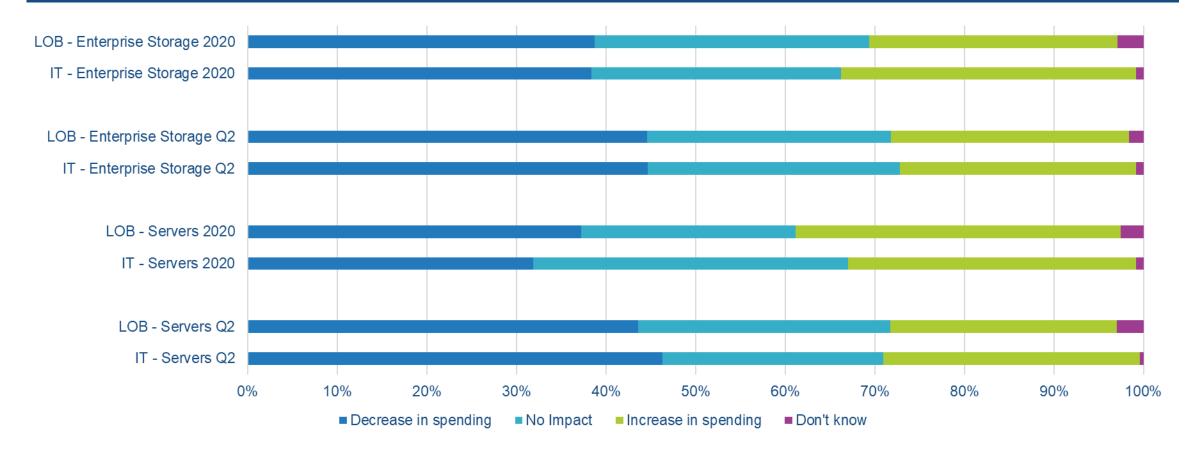


Wave 3 survey results show a strong shift towards a pessimistic outlook for 2020 within the USA

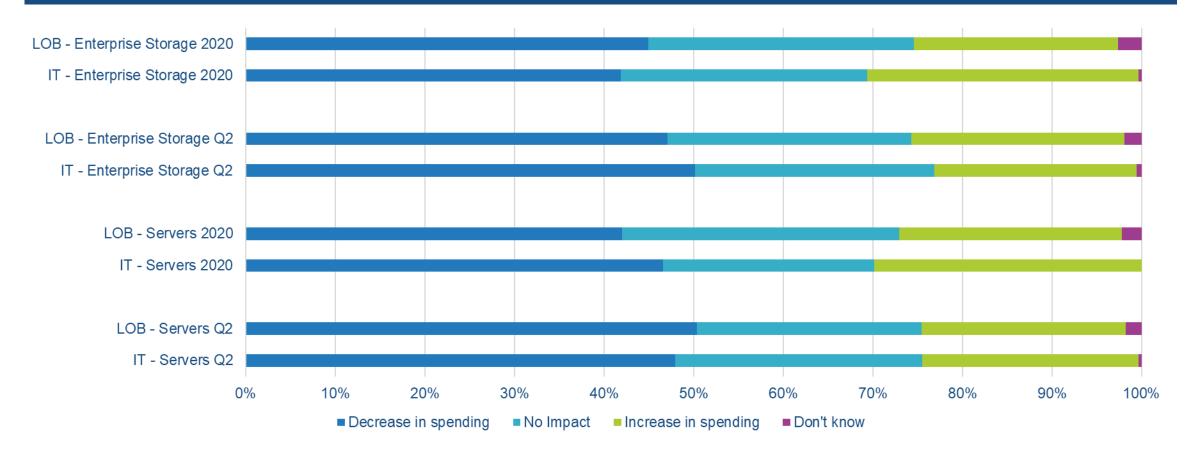

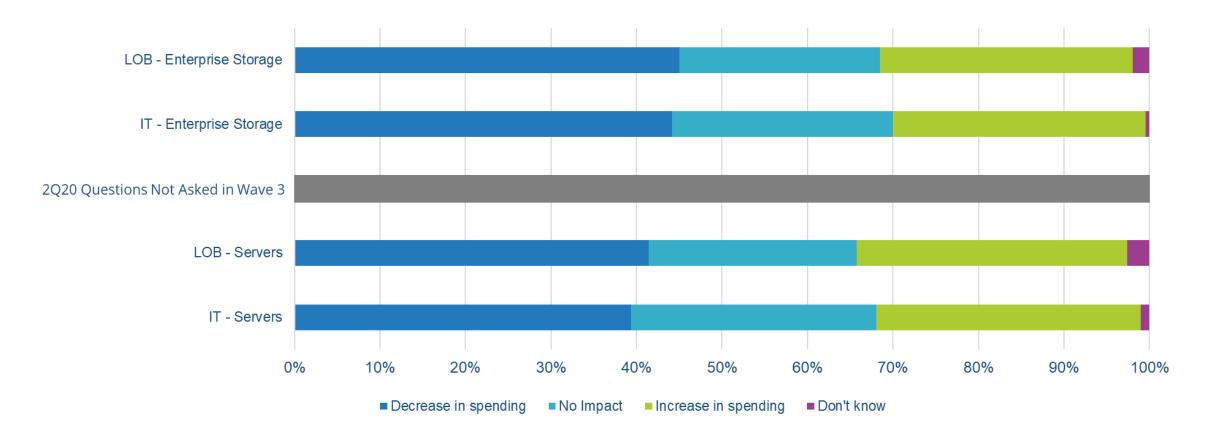

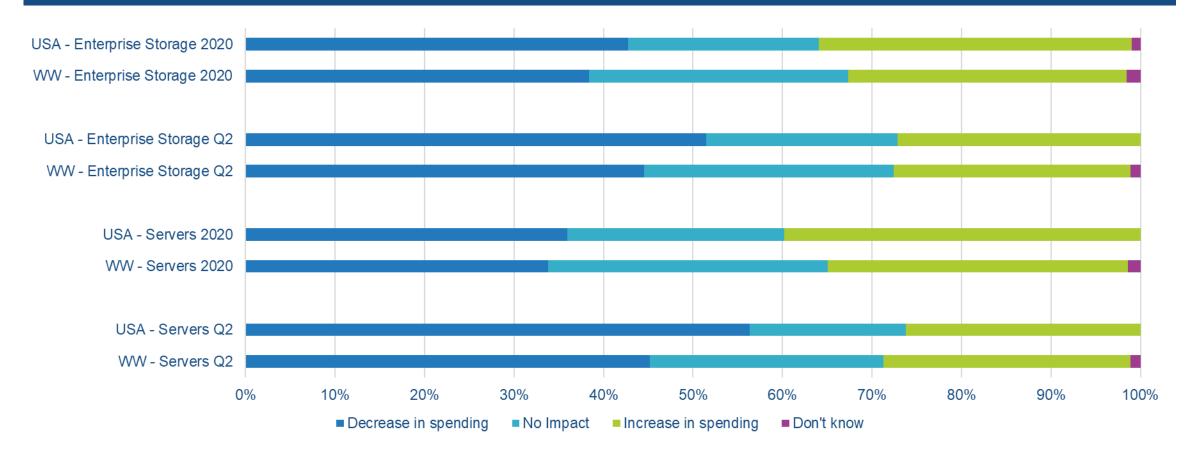

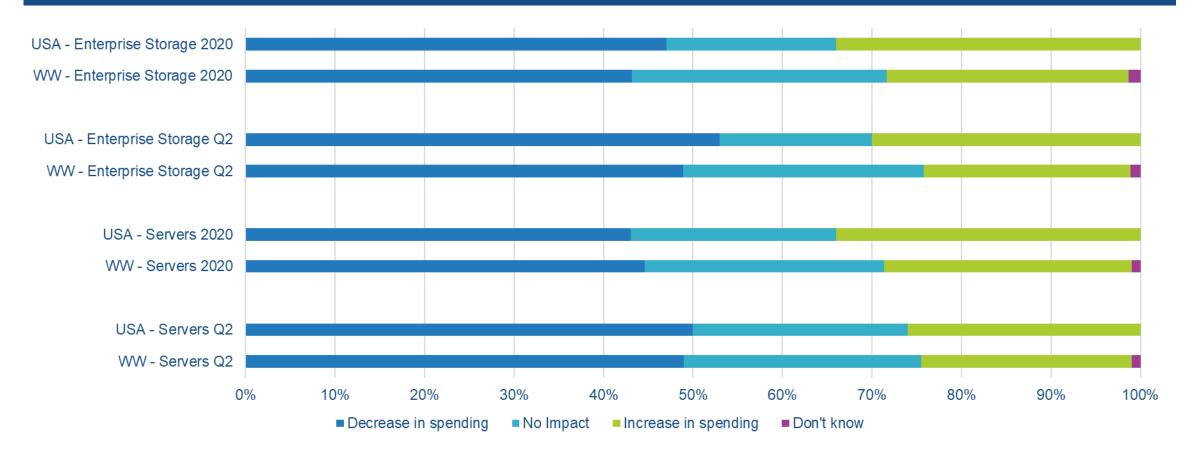

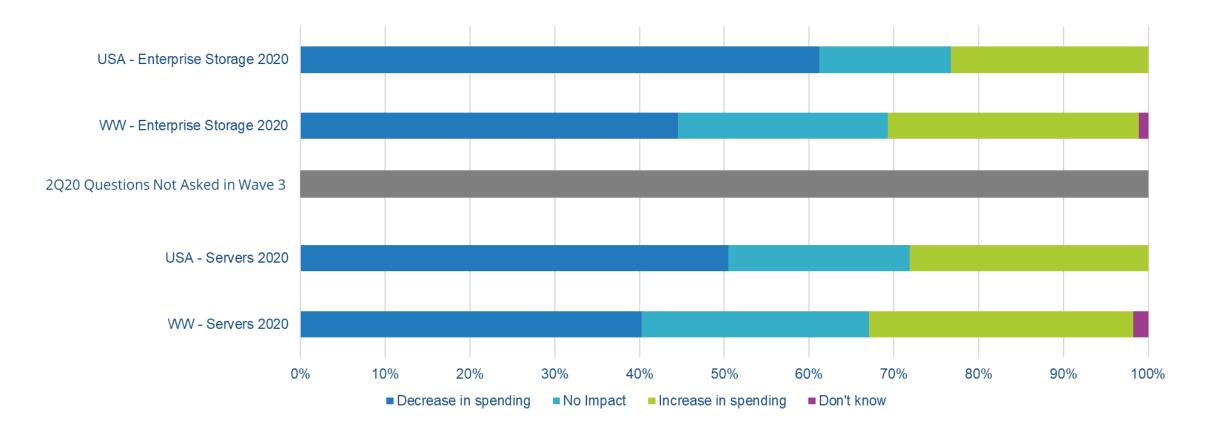
